Nanaimo Sports Hall of Fame Induction Criteria

Eligibility: Individual athletes, teams, and builders (e.g. officials, coaches, administrators, members of the media) who live or are from the Nanaimo area and have made significant contributions to sport in Nanaimo and elsewhere.

1. Athlete:

Must have attained a high level of excellence and brought recognition or honour to Nanaimo sport. There must be a waiting period of three years following retirement from open competition. In the event of death, or with the winning of an Olympic or World Championship medal, the waiting period is waived and the nomination is eligible for immediate consideration. An individual retired for three years but still competing in Seniors or Masters is eligible.

2. Builder: (Including Referee, Coach, Administrator, Service Club)

Must have attained a high level of excellence and brought honour to Nanaimo sport through ongoing dedication to the building of athletes, teams, or sport itself.

3. Pioneer:

Must have attained a high level of excellence and brought honour to Nanaimo sport during the period beyond 50 years prior to the current year. An exception to the 50 year limit would be individuals or teams in more recently developed sports that have some “pioneering” quality to their accomplishments. Teams will be selected for their achievements in one year that best represents their accomplishments.

4. Media:

Must have attained a high level of excellence and made a significant contribution to the enjoyment or knowledge of sport in Nanaimo through the medium of print, radio, television or any similar medium.

5. Team:

Attained a high level of excellence and brought recognition or honour to Nanaimo sport. Team members (players and coaches) are recognized as part of a team and not as an individual Member. Teams are selected for achievements in one year, not an era. A team is not eligible for nomination until three (3) years following the year for which a team is nominated except by winning an Olympic or a World championship medal whereby the nomination is eligible for immediate consideration.

Selection: The members inducted into the Hall of Fame will be individuals or teams whose names have been submitted by nomination to the Sports Hall of Fame Selection Panel. Anyone, except Sports Hall of Fame Committee and Selection Panel members and Museum Board members, can submit a nomination for consideration. The Sports Hall of Fame Selection Panel

will consider nominations from the current year as well as nominations from two induction years prior.

General

1. An Individual or Team who has been elected to Canada's Sports Hall of Fame or the British Columbia Sports Hall of Fame and Museum is not an automatic member of the Nanaimo Sports Hall of Fame.
2. Each Nomination is eligible for consideration for three induction years. Nomination may be resubmitted one year after the three-year eligibility period has passed.
3. The Selection Panel may move nominees to a category other than the one chosen on the nomination form.
