Spring Break Workshops at Nanaimo Museum

With spring break just around the corner, Nanaimo Museum is once again offering entertaining and educational workshops to give aspiring young minds the chance to be builders, creators and historians during their time off school.

The workshops, which are designed for students from Grades 3 to 7, run from Monday, March 8 to Friday March 12 from 10 am to 3 pm each day.

On Monday, students can build a motorized rowboat and race against fellow participants; on Tuesday they can construct a miner's cottage with miniature clay bricks and mortar; on Wednesday, attendees can build a catamaran out of plastic drink bottles and race in Nanaimo's second Sure to be Swift race; Thursday's Recycled Robot workshop will see students creating their own techno robot with moving arms; and Friday they can learn First Nations carving.

The cost for the workshops is \$25 each, or \$100 for all five. Museum members, however, receive a 15% discount.
